Checks may be written to Southern York Co. Food Pantry and given to Dorothy Warfield. Thanks!



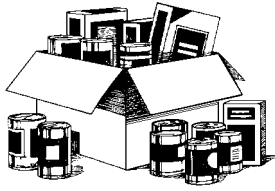
